
MOBILE APP DEVELOPMENT CLUB

Mobile app development club conducted an event Apptronics 2.0 on 15th October 2020, from 11:00 am onwards. The event was aimed at utilizing the information and skills imbibed like the prerequisite programming concepts and logic that will strengthen the foundation of critical thinking, and also for gaining the awareness of mobile app technology.

The event had three rounds namely Quiz time (consisting of technical MCQ), Quick Pic (Pictionary round) and the Final Battle (consisting of both, MCQs and Pictionary). 38 participants from ECE, CSE, ISE and BSH department participated in the event. 21 students were selected for the round 2 and final round had 12 students.



field of computer science. The event ended at 11:30 and 21 students were chosen for the second round.


The second round namely Quick Pic consisted of

The final round began at 1:00 PM and consisted of both, MCQ and Pictionary. The second round ended at 1:30 PM and the winners were announced.




