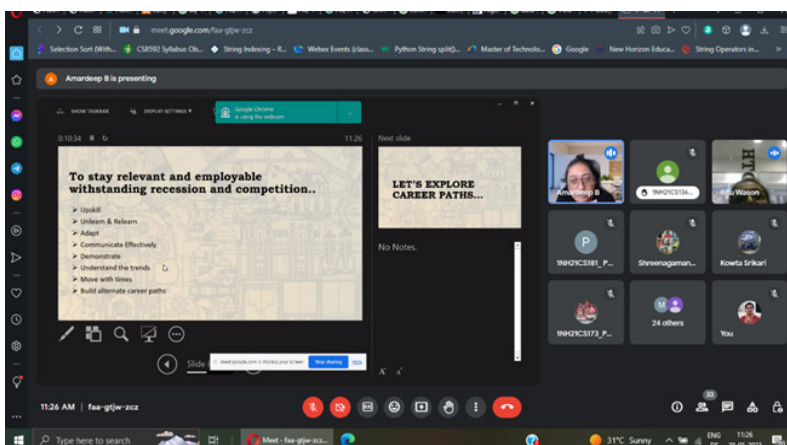
# HIGHER EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES IN UNITED STATES

Quantum computing is a multidisciplinary field comprising aspects of computer science, physics, and mathematics that utilizes quantum mechanics to solve complex problems faster than classical computers. It is used to solve mathematical problems and run quantum models using the tenets of quantum theory. Machine learning using quantum computers will result in improved pattern recognition, making it easier to predict extreme weather events and potentially saving thousands of lives a year.
