Bootstrap provides the capability to easily responsive designs, ensuring that websites create automatically adapt to look good on all devices, from small phones to large desktops. Bootstrap utilizes ¡Query for JavaScript plugins such as modals and tooltips. To enhance interactivity, JavaScript and CSS are incorporated into the website.
