


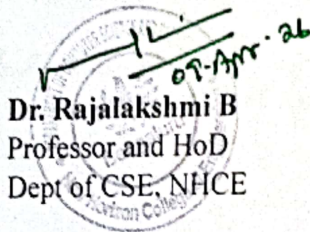

- 17) In the event of any clause in this MOU being found invalid, the remaining clauses shall remain in effect.




